The Ed and Caroline Strang EAGLE SCOUT SCHOLARSHIP is restricted on the following basis:

- A. Eagle Scouts from Troop 3 and Crew 33, Derby, Connecticut are to be given first consideration.**
- B. The Scholarship is open to Eagle Scouts from the Housatonic Council.**

Qualifications: The applicant must complete this application personally and meet the following requirements.

1. Have been granted the Eagle Scout Award. Applicants should ensure that they have been certified as an Eagle Scout prior to submission of the application.
2. Be a graduating High School senior and an entering college freshman in the year he is applying for a scholarship. Grants are awarded only to high school seniors graduating in the calendar year in which scholarships are presented.
3. Have an SAT score of at least 780 and/or ACT score of 20. Applicants must take the SAT or ACT in time to submit the results with the application.
4. Have demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and a strong record of participation in activities outside of Scouting.
5. Have the endorsement of a volunteer or professional Scout leader who knows the applicant personally.

Scholarships are granted on a one-time basis and are non renewable.

Applications will not be considered if postmarked later than Midnight, May 31.

This application becomes the property of the selection committee and will not be returned to the applicant.

The selection committee will inform all applicants of their decision on or before June 15.
